TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF BOAT REGISTRATION

1. Boat Size (LOD) Registration and Cost (including GST)

Boat registrations close on 15 October 2010. Any boat registrations submitted after 15 October 2010 will be subject to a late entry fee. Boat registration costs are as follows:

Category	Boat Size	Normal Entry Fee – for entries received up to 15 October 2010	Late Entry Fee – for entries received after 15 October 2010
1	Dinghy or boat under 20ft	\$25	\$50
2	Boat 20-50ft	\$50	\$100
3	Boat over 50ft	\$100	\$200
4	Multihull less than 35ft	\$100	\$200
5	Multihull over 35ft	\$150	\$300

Boat owners are particularly encouraged to enter large boats ashore on trailers or boats that are works in progress.

Note: Late entry fees do not apply for boats ashore.

2. Photographs

Two current colour photographs of the boat *must* be supplied with the boat registration form for docking and publicity purposes and must be good quality prints. At least one of the photographs must show the entire boat. Two digital photographs up to 100 kb in size would be preferred (approximately 400 Pixels wide x 300 Pixels high). If supplying hard copies of photographs, please write the name of the boat, owner and a telephone contact number on the back of the photographs. If supplying digital photographs, forward them to:

Photographs must be free of copyright and available for use on the AWBF website and for AWBF publicity purposes. Please advise if this is not so.

Boats may not be allocated a berth at the Festival if photographs of the boat have not been supplied to AWBF.

3. Registration Kit

Registered boats that arrive at the Festival will receive:

- Boat Sign
- Bronzed Plaque
- Festival Flag
- Festival Poster

An applicant who registers and who does not bring their boat to the Festival will not be entitled to receive any of the above benefits.

4. Rejection of Registration

The organisers reserve the right not to accept any registration received due to limited wharf space, limits on the numbers of some categories of boats, site limitations or any other reason.

5. Docking and Docking Positions (Boats Afloat)

Boats must be moored in the docking position allocated to boat owners.

The organisers reserve the right to change allocated docking positions at any time.

Due to limited wharf space and site restrictions, it is no longer possible to accommodate boat owner's special requests re their docking position except for people with disabilities.

Boat owners who have a permanent dock space in Kings Pier Marina are not guaranteed the same position for the Festival.

6. Boats Ashore

Boats displayed ashore will be located on the Festival site in thematic groupings. Boats may be displayed on trailers but owners are responsible for providing guarding and protection from trailer projections, chocking and tie-down arrangements. Details of arrival times and boat positions will be advised to owners closer to the date of the Festival. There is no parking available for cars on site.

6. Boats for Sale

Boat owners will be allowed to advertise their boats for sale at the Festival provided that the For Sale signs are small (no larger than A4), tasteful and discreet. AWBF reserves the right to remove the signs if they do not comply.

8. Withdrawals and Refunds

A boat owner whose application is rejected for any reason will have the registration cost refunded in full.

A boat owner who registers and who then withdraws before 15 October 2010 will have the registration cost refunded in full. A boat owner who registers and who then withdraws before 31 December 2010 will have 50% of the registration cost refunded. A boat owner who registers and who then withdraws after 31 December 2010 will forfeit all the registration cost.

A boat owner who registers and who then withdraws at any time will not be entitled to receive any of the benefits that are provided to registered boats that arrive at the Festival.

9. Disclaimer

Boat owners participate in the Festival at their own risk.
